REDSKINS NOTES

- **QB CASE KEENUM** passed for 3,547 yards with 22 TDs vs. 7 INTs for 98.3 rating in 2017 with Min. Has 2+ TD passes in 3 of his past 4 on road. Has 8 TDs (6 pass, 2 rush) vs. INT for 115.2 rating in 3 career road starts vs. NFC North.
- **RB ADRIAN PETERSON** spent 10 seasons (2007-16) with Min. & is franchise all-time leader in rush yards (11,747), rush TDs (97) & scrimmage yards (13,692). Has 115+ rush yards in 2 of his past 3 on road. Ranks 8th in NFL history with 13,625 career rush yards & needs 60 rush yards to surpass HOFers **JEROME BETTIS** (13,662) & **LADAINIAN TOMLINSON** (13,684) for 6th-most.
- **WR TERRY MCLAURIN** leads all rookies in receptions (24), rec. yards (419) & TD catches (5) in 2019. Has 3 rec. TDs in 2 career road games. Aims for his 3rd in row on road with 100+ rec. yards & TD catch. **WR PAUL RICHARDSON** aims for his 3rd in row vs. NFC North with TD catch.
- **LB RYAN KERRIGAN** has sack in 2 of his past 3 on road vs. NFC North. Since 2014, is 1 of 3 players (**AARON DONALD** & **CHANDLER JONES**) with 60+ sacks (62) & 15+ FFs (15). **DL MATT IOANNIDIS** had career-high 9 tackles in Week 7. Aims for his 3rd in row vs. NFC North with sack. **DE NOAH SPENCE** had 1st sack with Was. in Week 7. **S TROY APKE** had 1st career INT last week. **S LANDON COLLINS** has 18 tackles (9 per game) & 2 TFL in 2 career games vs. Min. Aims for his 10th in row on road with 6+ tackles.

VIKINGS NOTES

- **QB KIRK COUSINS** passed for 337 yards with 4 TDs vs. 0 INTs & 141.4 rating. Is 1st QB in NFL history with 300+ pass yards & 135+ rating in 3 consecutive games. Spent 6 seasons with Was. (2012-17) & had 16,206 pass yards with 99 TDs & 93.7 rating. Has 12 TDs vs. 2 INTs for 117.6 rating in his past 6 at home. Aims for his 4th in row at home with 110+ rating.
- **RB DALVIN COOK** had 149 scrimmage yards (142 rush, 7 rec.) & 2 rush TDs in Week 7. Leads NFL with 725 rush yards & 945 scrimmage yards in 2019. Has 6 rush TDs in his past 5 at home & aims for his 4th in row at home with rush TD. **FB C.J. HAM** had 1st career rush TD last week.
- **WR STEFON DIGGS** led team with 7 receptions for 142 yards last week. Aims for his 3rd in row with 7+ catches & 140+ rec. yards. Has 242 rec. yards (121 per game) & TD catch in 2 career games vs. Was. Has 7 rec. TDs in his past 7 at home. **WR ADAM THIELEN** aims for his 4th in row at home & 4th in row overall with rec. TD. **TE KYLE RUDOLPH** had TD catch in Week 7 & has rec. TD in 3 of his past 4 vs. Was.
- **DE DANIELLE HUNTER** had sack last week. Aims for his 3rd in row vs. Was. & 7th in row vs. NFC East with sack. **DE EVERSON GRIFFEN** had sack in Week 7. Has sack in 2 of his past 3 vs. Was. **LB ERIC KENDRICKS** led team with 12 tackles last week. Aims for his 3rd in row with 10+ tackles & 4th in row with 2+ PD. **S HARRISON SMITH** aims for his 4th in row vs. Was. with 7+ tackles.
