TITANS TEAM NOTES

- **TITANS** earned 2nd playoff berth in past 3 seasons. Won 9+ games for 4th-consecutive season, longest streak since 1987-93 (7 consecutive seasons).
- **MIKE VRABEL** makes postseason head coaching debut. Played LB for 8 seasons with NE (2001-08), winning 3 Super Bowls (XXXVI, XXXVIII, XXXIX).
- **TENNESSEE** had 2 players named to 2020 Pro Bowl: **RB DERRICK HENRY** & **P BRETT KERN**.
- **TITANS** ranked 4th in AFC with 25.1 points per game, team's highest mark since 2003 (27.2).
- **TENNESSEE** averaged 138.9 rush yards per game, 3rd-most in NFL & most by Ten. in single season since 2009 (162 rush yards per game).

PATRIOTS TEAM NOTES

- **PATRIOTS** won AFC East division title for 11th-consecutive season, longest streak in NFL history. Won 12 games for 9th time in past 10 seasons.
- **BILL BELICHICK** has most playoff experience (42 games) & postseason wins (31) among HC in NFL history. Has 6 Super Bowl victories, most all-time among head coaches.
- **NEW ENGLAND** had 3 players named to 2020 Pro Bowl: **CB STEPHON GILMORE**, **LB DONT'A HIGHTOWER** & **ST MATTHEW SLATER**.
- **PATRIOTS** allowed 275.9 yards per game, fewest by NE team since 1977 (259.9), & allowed a league-low 14.1 points per game, fewest in NFL since 2008 Steelers (13.9).
- **NEW ENGLAND** had +21 turnover differential, best in NFL.

TITANS NOTES

- **QB RYAN TANNEHILL** passed for 2,742 yards with 22 TDs vs. 6 INTs in 12 games this season & set career highs in comp. pct. (70.3) & league-high rating (117.5), 4th-highest rating in single season among qualified passers in NFL history. Has 19 TDs (16 pass, 3 rush) vs. 2 INTs for 129.8 rating in his past 7. Had 3 TDs vs. 0 INTs for 155.2 rating in his last game vs. NE (12/9/18 with Mia.). Makes 1st-career postseason start.
- **RB DERRICK HENRY** led NFL with career-high 1,540 rush yards in 2019 & tied for league lead with career-high 16 rush TDs. Joined HoFer **EARL CAMPBELL** & **CHRIS JOHNSON** as only players in franchise history with 1,000+ rush yards & 10+ rush TDs in consecutive seasons. Rushed for season-high 211 yards & 3 TDs in Week 17. Has 240 scrimmage yards (120 per game) in 2 career postseason games.
- **WR A.J. BROWN** led all rookies with 1,051 rec. yards & tied for lead with 8 TD catches this season, 2nd rookie in franchise history with 1,000+ rec. yards. Has 100+ rec. yards & TD in 3 of past 4. **WR COREY DAVIS** had 43 catches for 601 yards & 2 TDs in 2019. Has 2 TD catches in 2 career postseason games. Had 7 catches for 125 yards & TD in last meeting.
- **CB LOGAN RYAN** set career highs in tackles (113), PD (18), sacks (4.5), & FFs (4) this season. Had 41 PD, 13 INTs & 3 FFs in 4 seasons with NE (2013-16). **S KEVIN BYARD** led team with 5 INTs. Since 2017, leads NFL with 17 INTs. **LB HAROLD LANDRY** led team with career-high 9 sacks in 2019.

PATRIOTS NOTES

- **QB TOM BRADY** passed for 4,057 yards with 24 TDs vs. 8 INTs in 2019, his 11th season with 4,000+ pass yards, tied 3rd-most in NFL history. Is all-time postseason leader in games played (40), wins (30), completions (1,005), pass yards (11,179) & TD passes (73). Has 16 playoff games with 300+ pass yards, most in NFL history. Aims for his 13th postseason game in row with 250+ pass yards.
- **RB SONY MICHEL** rushed for team-high 912 yards & career-high 7 TDs in 2019. Has 100+ scrimmage yards in 2 of past 3. Has rushed for 336 yards (112 per game) & 6 TDs in 3 career postseason games. **RB JAMES WHITE** ranked 2nd among AFC RBs in rec. yards (645), tied for 2nd in rec. TDs (5) & 3rd in catches (72) in 2019. Has rush TD in 2 of his past 3 home postseason games.
- **WR JULIAN EDELMAN** led team with 100 catches for career-high 1,117 yards this season. Ranks 2nd in postseason history with 115 catches. Had 26 catches for 388 yards (129.3 per game) in 3 postseason games last season. **WR PHILLIP DORSETT** had career-high 5 rec. TDs in 2019. Has rec. TD in 2 of past 3 postseason games.
- **CB STEPHON GILMORE** tied for league lead with career-high 6 INTs this season. Had INT in 2 of 3 playoff games last season. **CB DEVIN MCCOURTY** had 7 PD, 5 INTs & 2 FFs this season. **LB JAMIE COLLINS** led team with career-high 7 sacks. Was only player in 2019 with 7+ sacks & 3+ INTs.
